PERCUSSION





Percussion involves several pieces of equipment that need to be purchased.

Your child will need the following equipment:

- o Innovative 12" Red Gun Rubber Pad or Sabian 14" Quiet Tone Snare Pad
- o Snare Height Practice Pad Stand w Basket Standard
- o Vic Firth SD1 General Snare Drum Sticks 1 pair
- o Vic Firth M123 Marimba Mallets 1 pair
- o Percussion Stick/Mallet Bag
- o Wire Music Stand
- o Metronome/Tuner Korg TM60 *or* TE Tuner App on smart phone

It is **strongly advised** to rent a student mallet instrument for home for the months of October to April during the school year. We have instruments available to use at school, but they may not always be available for practice before and after school.

PLEASE DO NOT PURCHASE SUBSTITUTES FOR THE EQUIPMENT LISTED UNLESS APPROVED BY A DIRECTOR - Proper equipment is essential for your child's development technically and if they have "cheaper" off brand equipment this can greatly hinder their success.

TIMELINE

March/April/May

- o Meet with directors to select an instrument
- o Order the listed equipment from a local music retailer
- o Sign up for private lessons to get an early start in the summer if desired contact a director for more information

June

- o Pick up school owned instrument if starting private lessons during the summer contact a director to schedule this
- o Order supplies if not already done

<u>July</u>

o Verify that you have all equipment needed. Label all supplies clearly.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

<u>Is it ok for my child to start playing before the school year starts?</u> If your child would like to start with a private lesson teacher early, this is great! Please contact a director for this information. It is NOT ok for your child to pull out their instrument on their own and attempt to start playing without the guidance of a professional. This could cause them to create bad embouchures, tones, and habits that are hard to correct down the road.

When should I bring my instrument to school next year? We will have you bring your instrument (if rented through a local music store) and supplies the 2nd or 3rd day of school. No need to bring anything the first day of school.

If we are renting our child's instrument from a local music store, when will it arrive to the school? Some music stores will deliver instruments and any supplies purchased directly to our campus. Depending on how early they are ordered, some will arrive in the summer before school starts.

<u>Can I purchase instruments or equipment other than what is listed?</u> We have found not all instruments and equipment are manufactured to the same standards. The items listed on your materials list as approved selections have been chosen and cleared by the band staff based on years of experience. Purchasing an instrument not listed for your child could hinder your child's development and progress. Instrument (brands) purchased from Amazon such as Mendini, Eastman, Eastar, Hawk, and Apollo, etc, are NOT acceptable instruments for your child.

What if we have an instrument from a family or friend that my child can use? Many times, instruments that sit for periods will need cleaning and maintenance due to stuck slides/valves, dried out pads, etc. Please contact a director if the brand/model is different from the list to ensure it is an appropriate instrument for a student to start on.
